

PROGRAM DESIGN

- Our curriculum teaches life skills through running games and workouts. The curriculum is based on extensive educational research and “on-the-track” testing of lessons.
- The three-part curriculum is taught by certified Girls on the Run® coaches and covers:
 - Part 1: Who am I? What are my values?
What are my goals?
 - Part 2: Team building: What does it mean to be supportive and supported?
 - Part 3: Finding my place and my voice in the community.
- Girls may choose and conduct a community service project as part of the 6-week session. *(In Lycoming County, some of these projects have included work with the SPCA, Appalachian Horse Help and Rescue, Salvation Army, Shepherd of the Streets)*
- At the program’s conclusion, girls are encouraged to complete a running event in their community with their team members.

RESULTS TO DATE

- Academic evaluation of the program shows a “statistically significant” improvement in body image, eating attitudes and self-esteem.
- Anecdotal evidence also indicates an improved sense of identity and an increasingly active lifestyle for program participants.
