### Family Guidelines For Indoor Visitation

- Indoor visitation will occur in designated visitation areas.
- Residents who are in quarantine due to recent hospitalizations or other conditions that pose a risk for exposure to Covid-19 reside in the “Yellow Zone” and are not able to leave that area for in person visits.
- Visitation in a designated visitation area may be too stressful for some residents (ex. residents with cognitive impairment, residents with some specific medical conditions, etc...). Please contact social services staff prior to scheduling your visit to discuss concerns and the best plan for your visit.
- Window visits, face time, and other alternative methods of visiting will continue for residents who are not able to safely enjoy in person visits.
- Visits must be scheduled 48 hours in advance.
  - o Visits may be scheduled during the following times:
    - Mondays- 1:30pm-3:45pm
    - Wednesdays- 7:00pm-7:45pm
    - Fridays- 1:30pm-3:45pm
    - Saturdays- 9:00am-11:15am
  - o Unscheduled visits cannot be accommodated.
  - o Please arrive 5 minutes early to allow for screening prior to the visit.
  - o Visitors who arrive late will need to end their visit at the scheduled end time so the area can be cleaned and the next visit is not disrupted.
- Each resident may have one scheduled visit weekly, on a first come first served basis. Residents who do not receive a visit one week will be given priority the next week.
- Please enter the main entrance at the front of the building. A staff member will complete our screening tool and assist you to the visitation area.
- During Your Visit
  - o All visitors will be screened for risk for factors for Covid 19 when arriving to visit.
    - Do not visit if you have felt sick or are experiencing fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, or vomiting/diarrhea. If you develop any symptoms during your visit, please notify staff and end your visit immediately.

- Do not visit if you have traveled to areas identified to have increased risk of COVID-19.
  - Do not visit if you have been in contact in the prior 2 weeks with anyone who has been positive or suspicious for COVID-19.
  - Hands must be sanitized when arriving and leaving .
  - Masks must be in place during screening and remain on for the entire visit.
  - Do not bring food or drink to be consumed during the visit.
  - Each resident may have two visitors.
  - Visitors and residents must remain seated during the entire visit.
  - The visit may not last longer than 30 minutes.
  - A staff member must remain in the area to ensure that safety guidelines are maintained and to assist residents/visitors as needed.
  - No pets may visit at this time.
  - Visitors may have some physical contact with residents (ex. hugging) as long as masking and hand hygiene are in place.
- If the Visit Guidelines are not followed, you will be asked to leave and further visitation could be restricted.

**Please Note: Someone who has received both doses of the Covid Vaccine and is considered fully immunized may still be able carry and transmit the virus to others or may still be able to become ill if exposed to the Covid-19 virus. We still need to be cautious.**
