

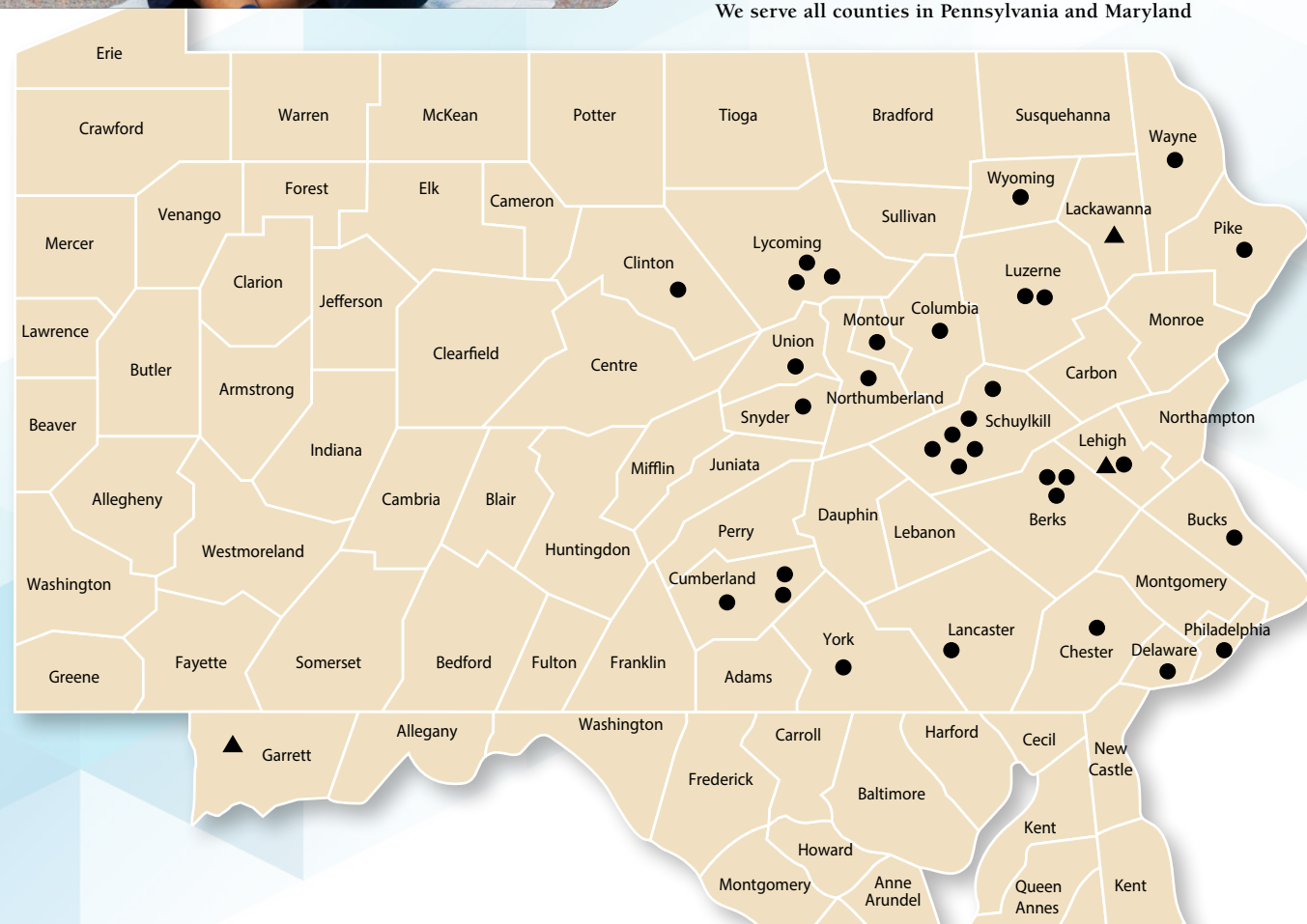


HOUSING SERVICES

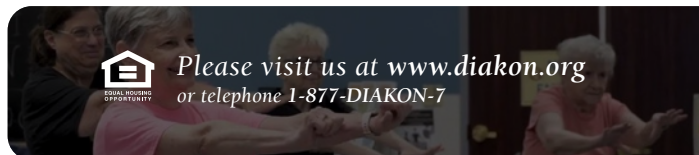
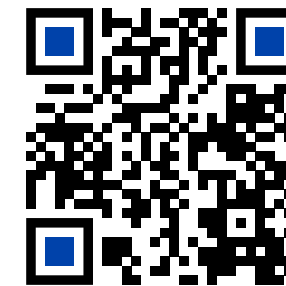

Connects with individuals 60+ to check on their well-being and provide resources as needed to support their emotional, mental, and physical health in Luzerne County.

Behavioral Health Services

Family-Based Mental Health for Problematic Sexual Behaviors – Intensive community-based services for youth with problematic sexual behaviors

Family Based Mental Health – Intensive family therapy and community-based services for high-risk youth

School Based Counseling - Mental health and substance abuse counseling for students in select school districts

Clinic-Based Services - Mental health and substance abuse counseling services for youth, adults and families. Individual, group and family counseling offered. Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) for substance abuse and psychiatric services

Children's Review Team - Care is coordinated across child-serving systems to make sure youth and families receive comprehensive, collaborative support, aiming to reduce the need for or length of residential treatment placements. From intake through discharge and follow-up, we facilitate timely referrals, empower the family, and promote continuity of care.

Family Reunification & Preservation Services

Diakon Family Reunification & Preservation Services - Family reunification is an intensive service designed to support children and youth in out-of-home placements, such as foster or residential care, who have the primary goal of returning to their biological families. Diakon's home-based, intensive family preservation program works to prevent placement by equipping families with tools, therapy, and support to maintain a safe and stable home environment.

Other programs provide early, in-home, and school-based interventions that strengthen families, promote stability, and help children thrive—whether by building parenting skills, addressing truancy, or supporting children with disabilities. Through programs like Stepping Stones, Resource Navigation, Positive

Parenting, and Court Parent Support, families receive personalized guidance, access to resources, and advocacy to reduce risk and keep children safely at home.

Diakon Family Finding & Family Engagement, serving youth referred by the county's Children, Youth & Families agency, works to promote permanency by identifying supportive networks and lasting connections that help youth safely remain with or return to their family, while also building sustainable relationships that support their long-term well-being.

CENTRAL PENNSYLVANIA REGION

The Weekend Alternative Program (WAP) is an alternative to more extensive out-of-community placements or as a first response for youth who have begun to head down the wrong path in life, the Weekend Alternative Program operates Friday through Sunday.

The Bridge Program – Central Region is a community-based mentor services. Offers a seven-day community-based alternative and diversion for pre- and post-adjudicated and dependent youth by working collaboratively with county agencies, schools, youth, families and the community.

Center Point Day Program is a community-based program that features individualized programming for students who struggle in a traditional school environment.

Wilderness Greenhouse & Native-Plant Nursery has provided space for students to learn, grow and develop life skills. Our 15,000-square-foot greenhouse not only houses our horticultural program but also serves as a sort of living machine, recycling and filtering the wilderness center campus wastewater to protect the quality of the Little Dogwood, a small tributary to the Yellow Breeches Creek.

Youthful Offenders Program is designed for young adults ages 18 through 25. Its focus is on pre-trial, first-time felony offenders who have been assessed by their home county as potentially able to benefit from a second chance and thus avoid the burden of a felony charge on their record.

Group Adventure Challenge & Team Development (for all ages and open to the public) provides group team building activities.

SOUTHEAST PENNSYLVANIA REGION

Bridge is community-based mentor services. Offering a seven-day community-based alternative and diversion for pre- and post-adjudicated and dependent youth by working collaboratively with county agencies, schools, youth, families and the community. Bridge provides community-based support to address individual needs and environmental factors that may lead to at-risk behaviors.

The PREP Programs are evening reporting programs for afterschool and evening programming that offer pro-social and an employability evening reporting model for community connection with pre- and post-adjudicated delinquent and dependent male and female youth ages 13 – 19.
