What is the Children's Review Team?

The Children's Review Team (CRT) serves as a collaborative liaison within Chester County, connecting youth experiencing serious emotional disturbances with appropriate community-based resources. Through coordination within the System of Care model, CRT works to ensure that services are integrated, accessible, and effective—helping to prevent unnecessary out-of-home placements and supporting youth in remaining safely within their homes and communities.
